Resolution to Support the Save Health Insurance for Working Families Campaign

WHEREAS, the California Labor Federation is launching a campaign to Save the Health Insurance for Working Families; and

WHEREAS, employers are trying to make unions pay for increases in healthcare; and

WHEREAS, last year California's unions fought to pass the Health Insurance Act, which requires large businesses to provide health insurance for their workers and protects workers from steep increases in premiums and out-of-pocket expenses; and

WHEREAS, now giant corporations like McDonald's, Macy's, and Wal-Mart are spending millions of dollars on a November ballot referendum to kill this Health Insurance Act,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the San Francisco Labor Council supports and endorses the campaign to Save Health Insurance for Working Families; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this resolution will be sent to all affiliates requesting affiliate participation and support.
