SAN FRANCISCO BALLOT MEASURES

A	City Budget Process: Proposes to amend the City Charter to establish a rolling 2-year budget cycle, a fixed deadline for union contract settlements, a deadline for arbitration awards if a positive benefit to any bargaining unit is to be implemented by July 1 of the same year, and establishes a 5 year long-term planning component.	NO
B	Board of Supervisor Aides: Proposes to amend the City Charter to delete the explicit denotation of "two", referring to the number of aides the supervisors are entitled to employ by the Charter.	YES
C	Candlestick Park Naming Rights: Ordinance permitting Rec & Park Dept. to expand the list of companies the 49ers may contract for the naming rights to Candlestick Park required since the voters declared the name of the stadium to be "Candlestick Park." Also establishes that it shall be City policy that not less than 50% of said revenue, subject to Charter restrictions, shall be used to fund RPD recreation center directors.	YES
D	Mid-Market Street Special Sign District: Ordinance amending the Planning Code to create an exemption from the Sec. 611 of the Planning Code established by voters restricting general advertising (billboards etc.) in order to permit a special sign district between 5 th & 7 th Streets along Market Street, and running one half block zig-zag north and south of Market Street.	No Recommendation
E	Advertisements on City Property: Ordinance prohibiting new general advertising on street furniture and city-owned property above levels of advertising approved as of January 1, 2008.	YES
